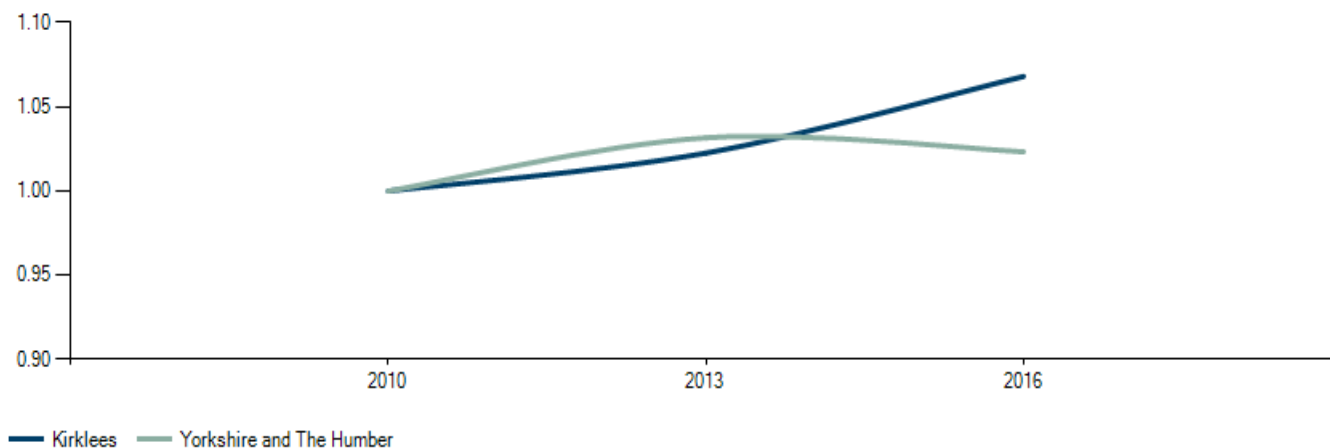

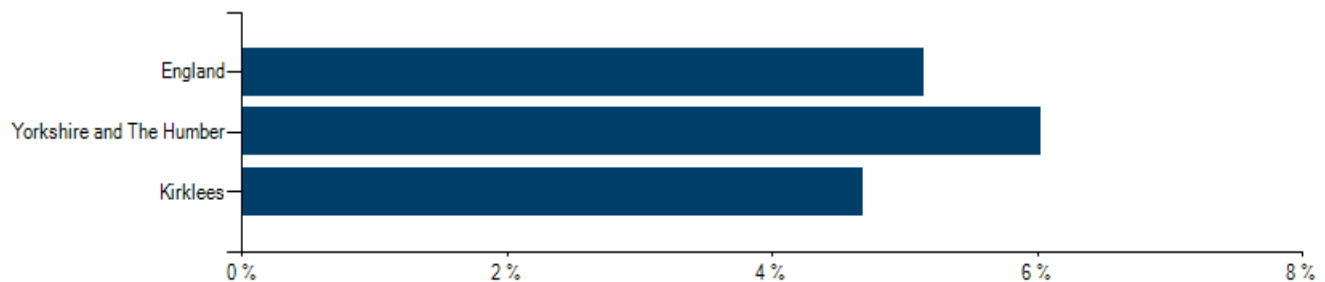

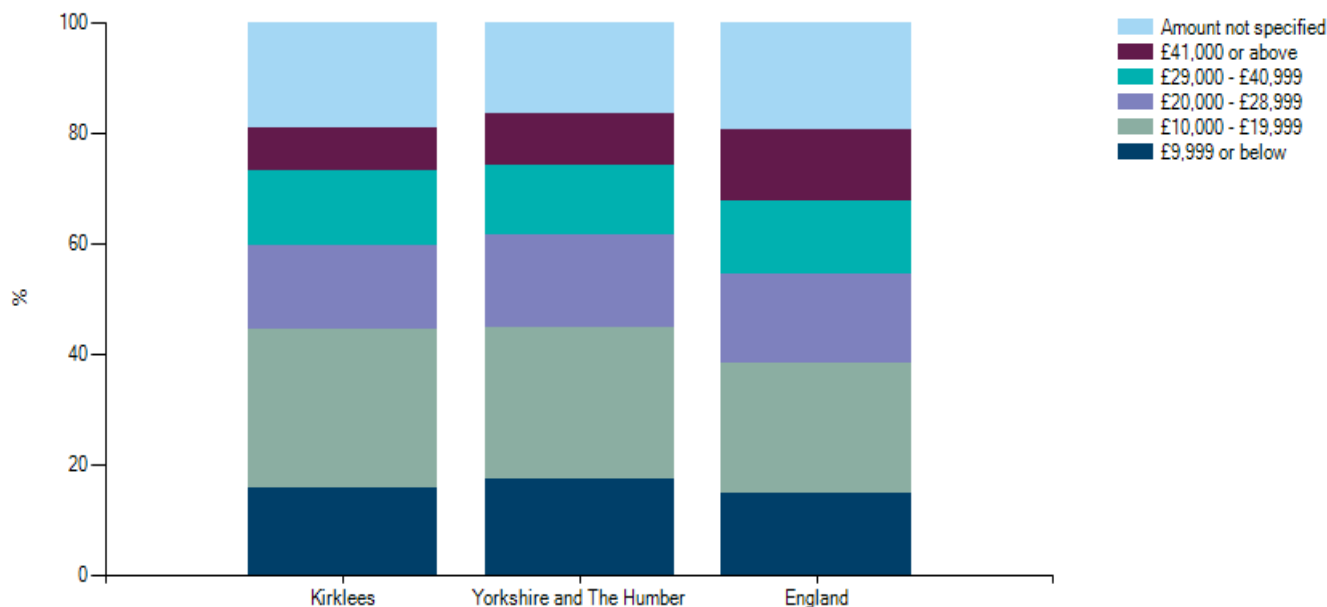

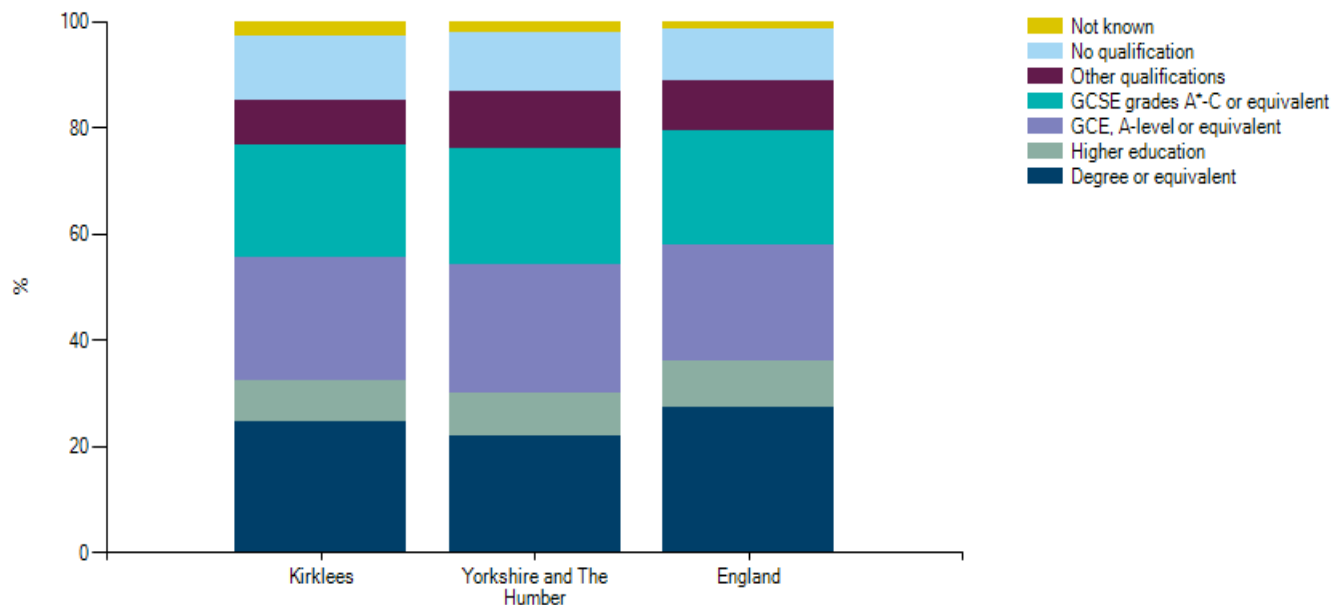

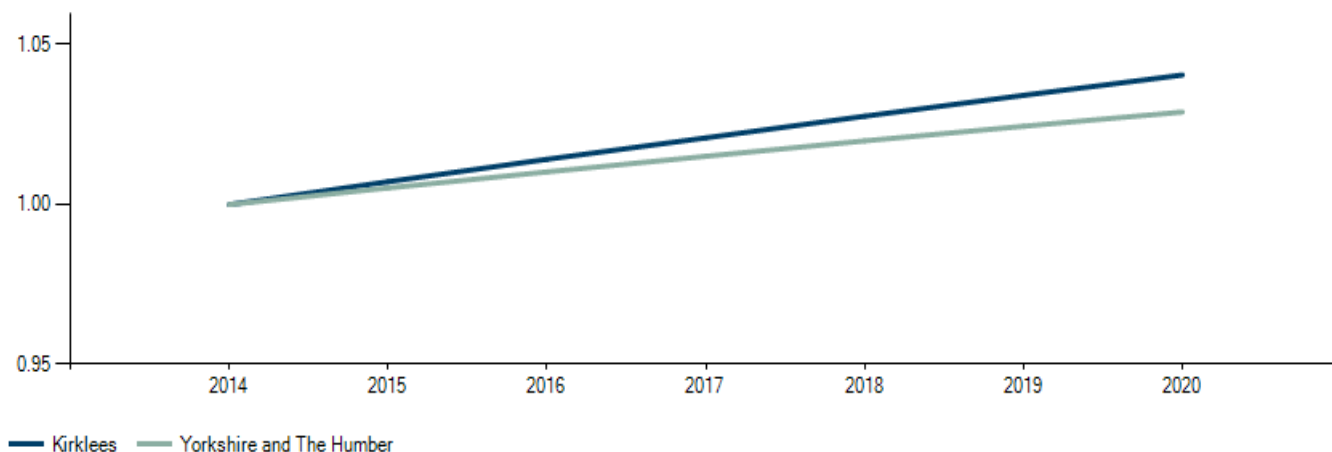

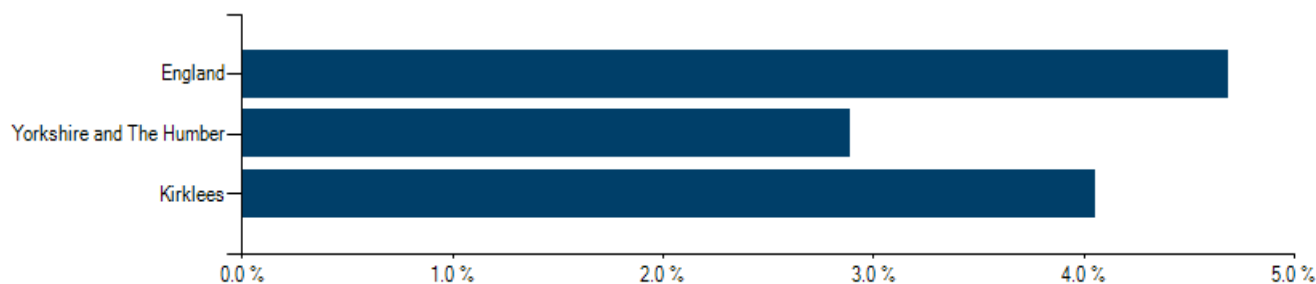

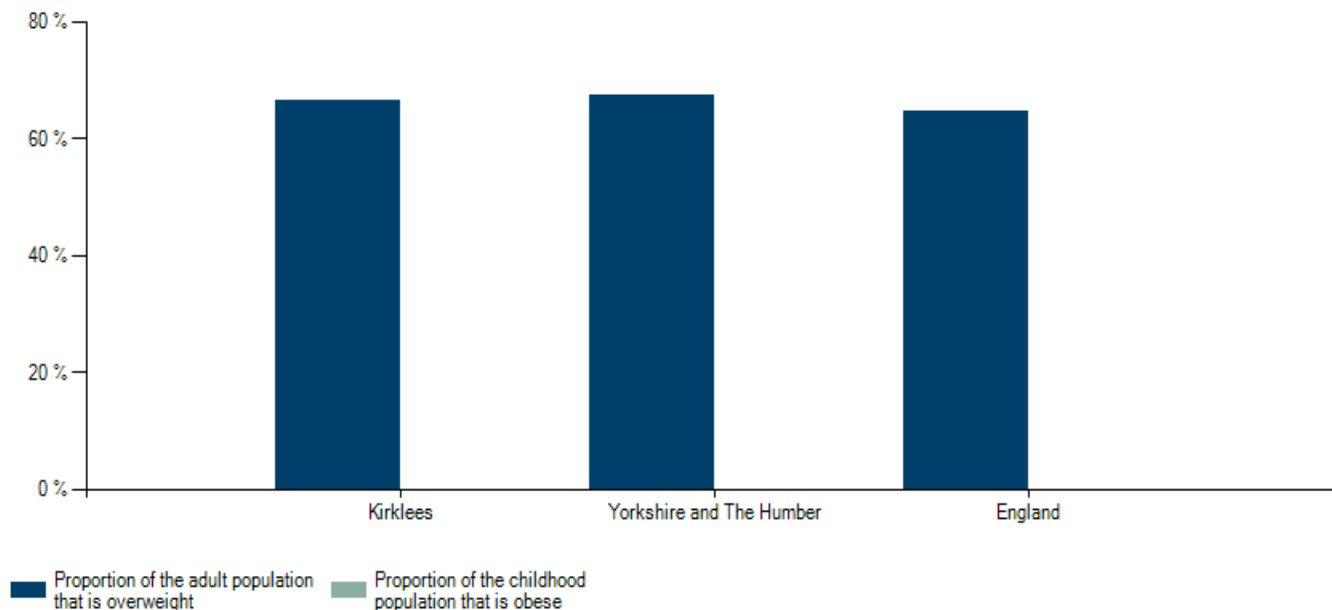

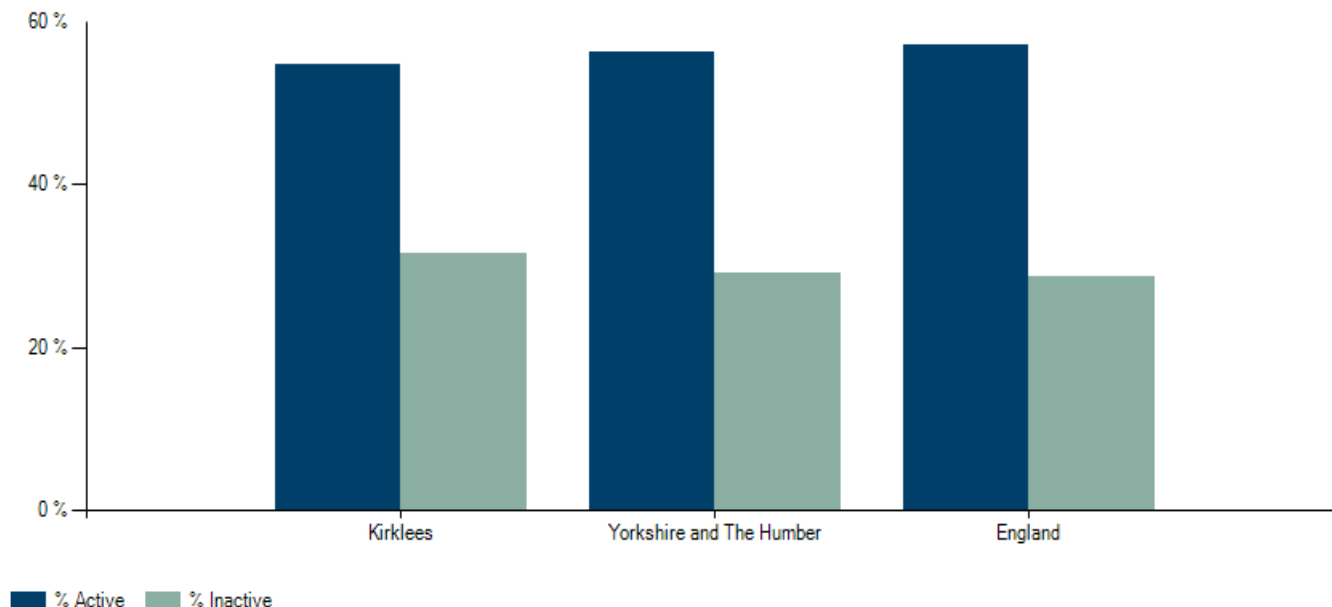

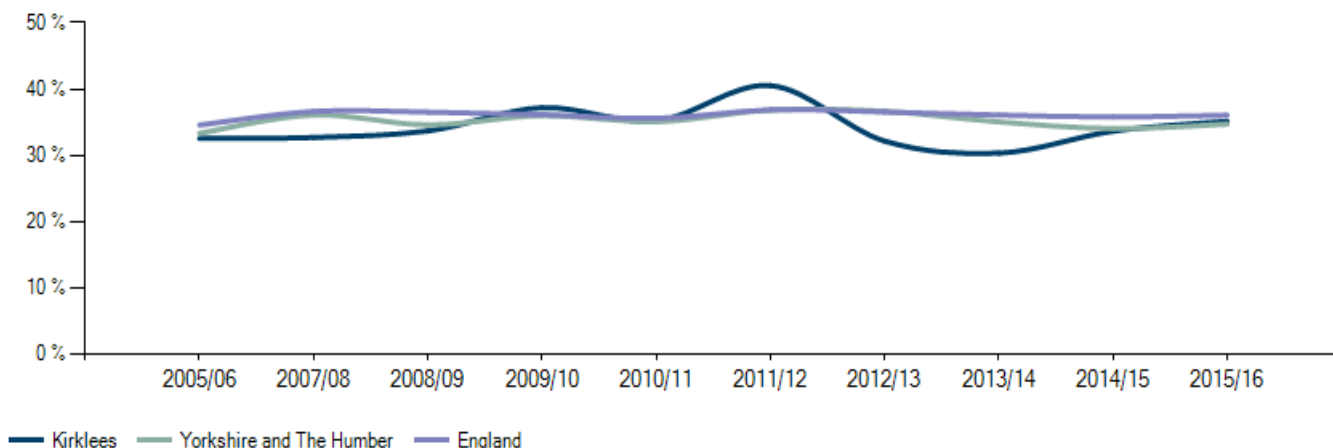

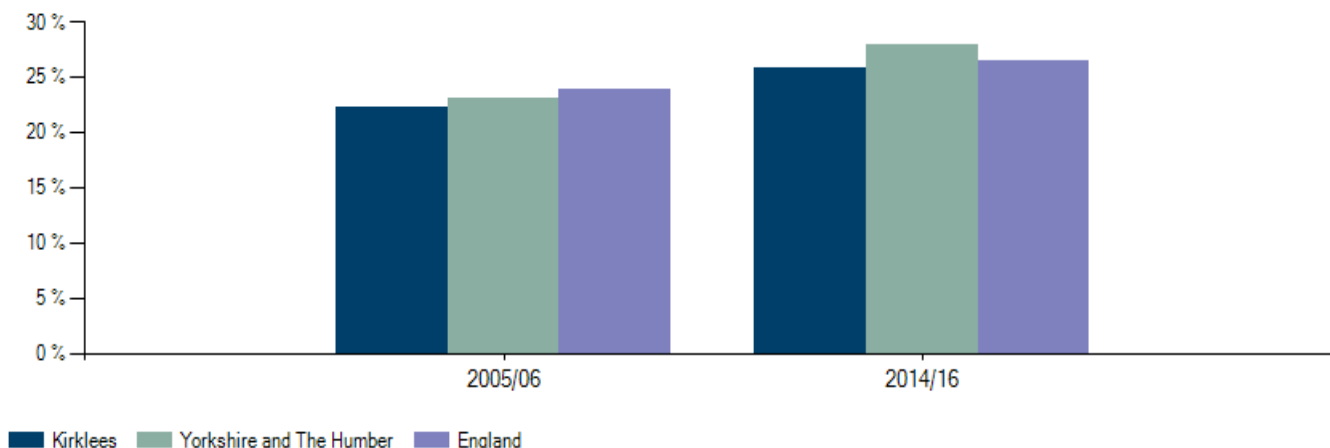
#### Total participation 3x30 (12 days plus)

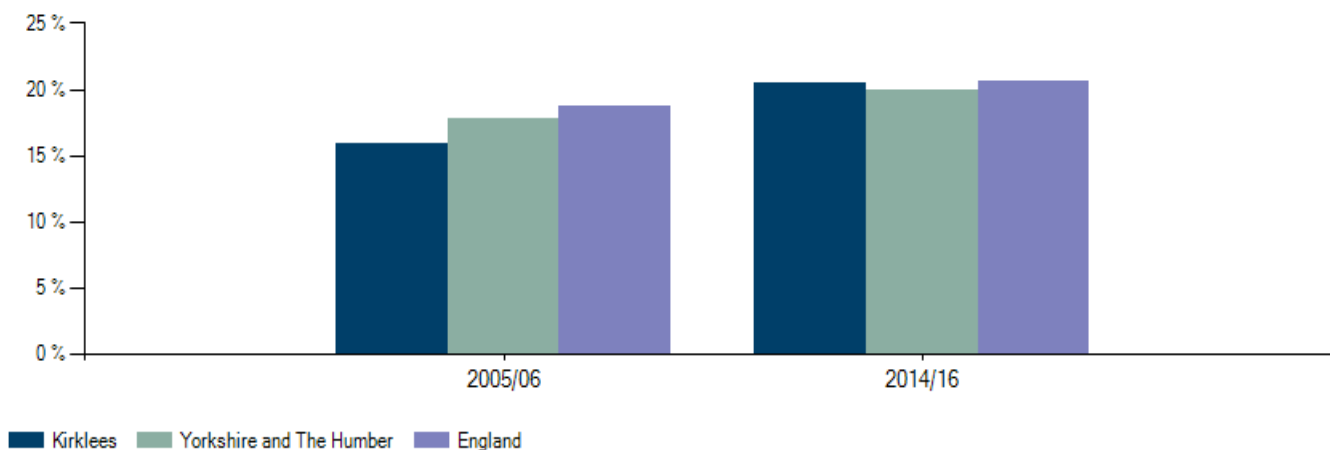
### Male participation 3x30 (12 days plus)

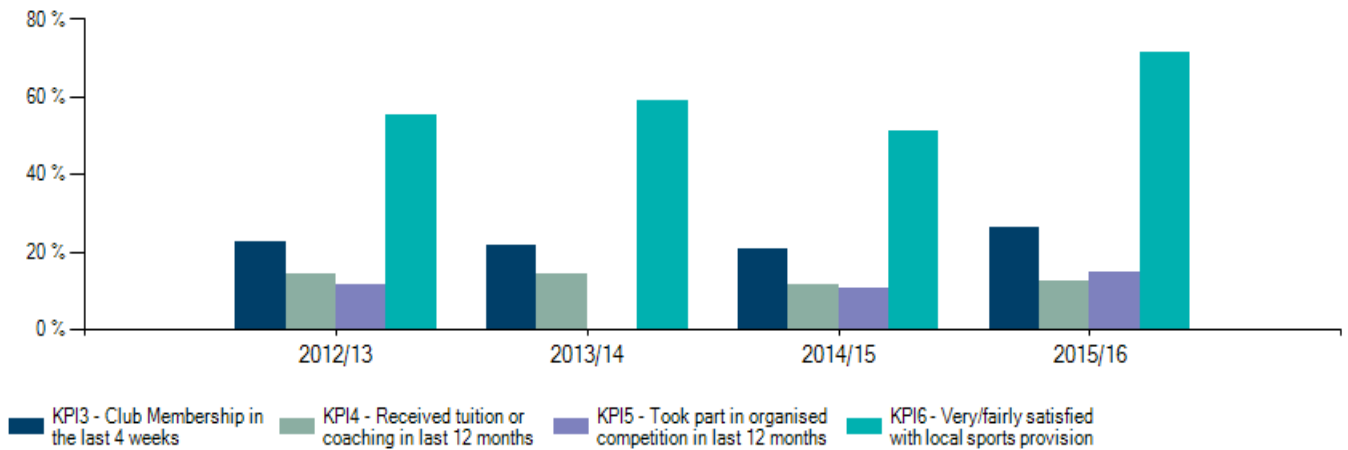

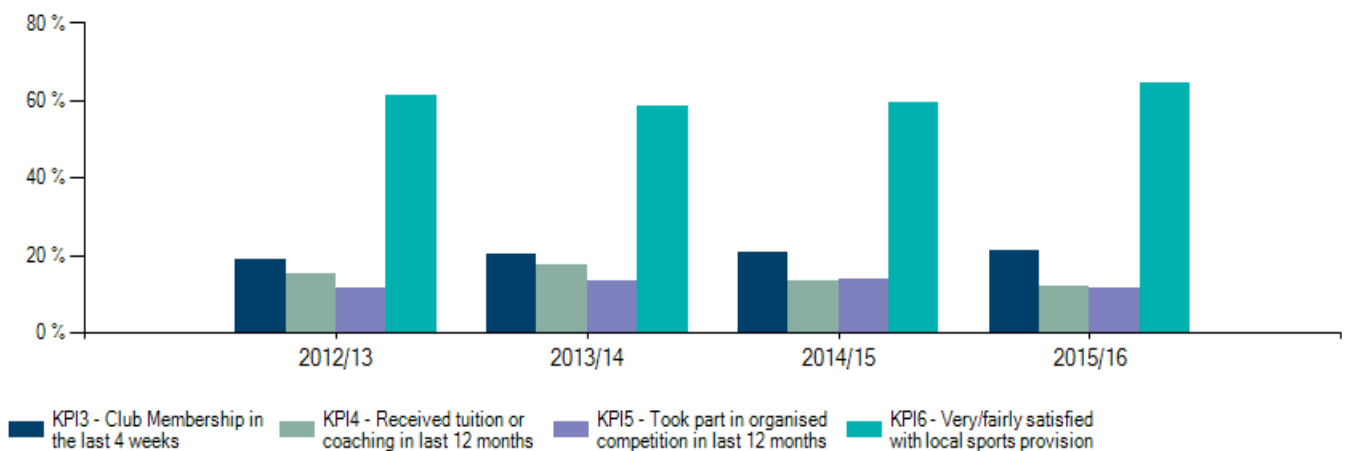

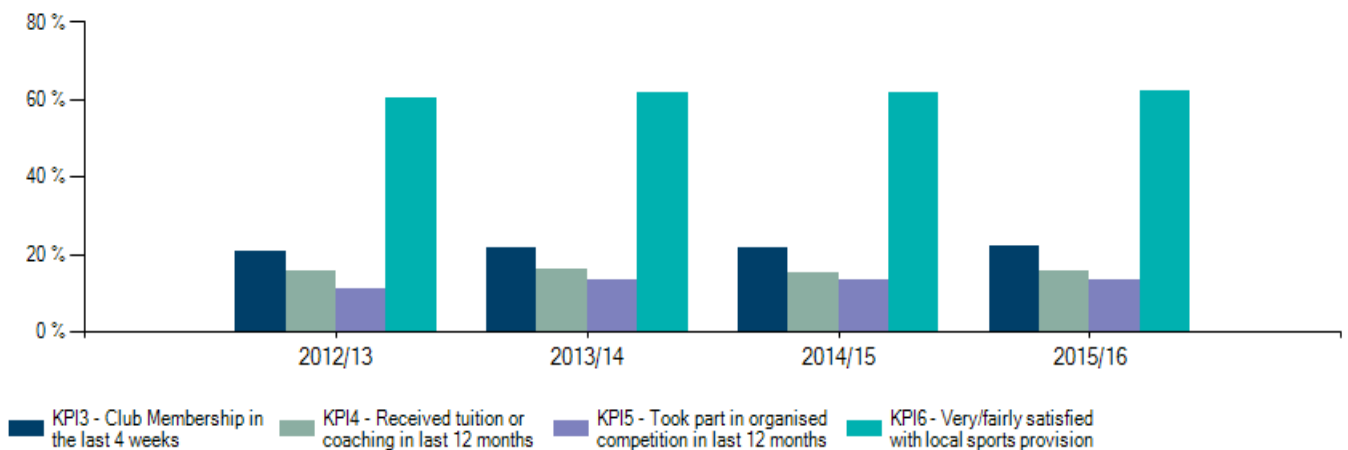

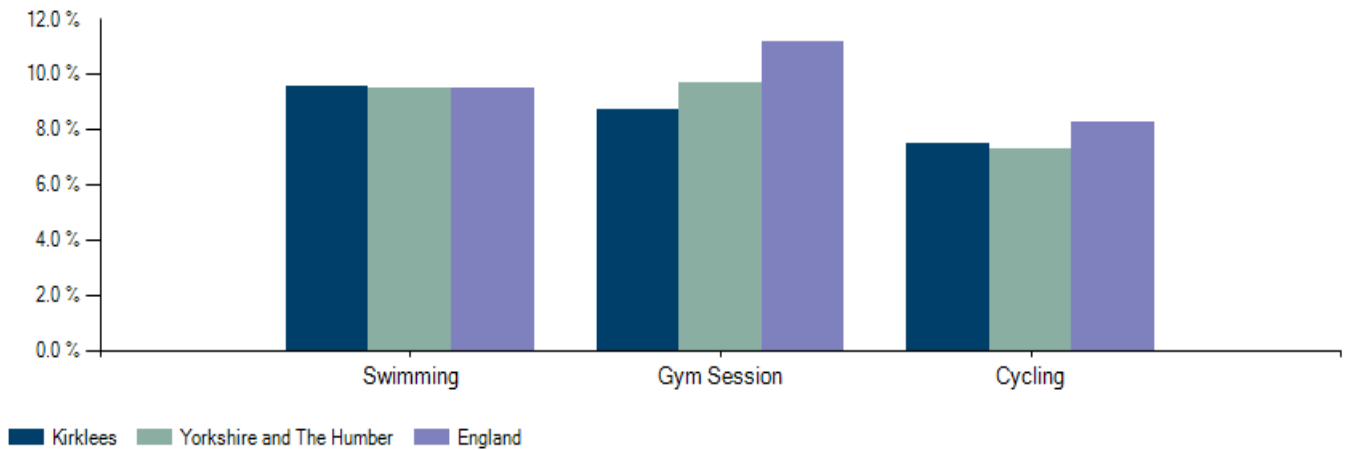

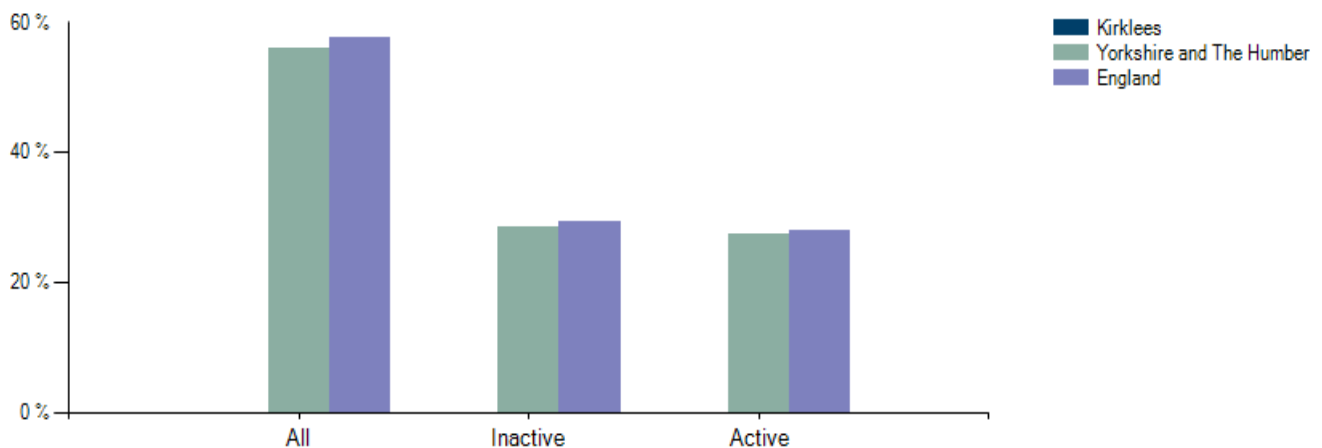

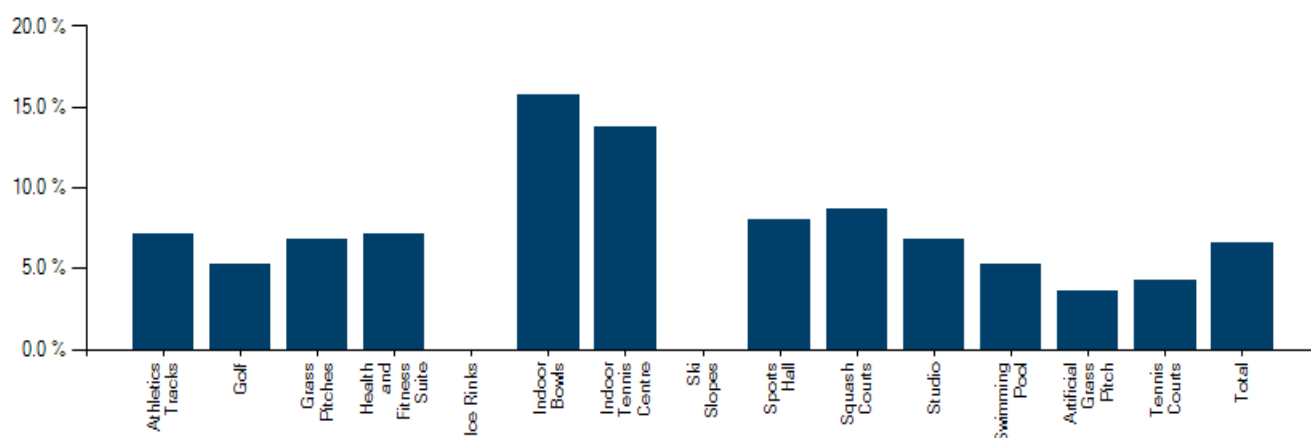

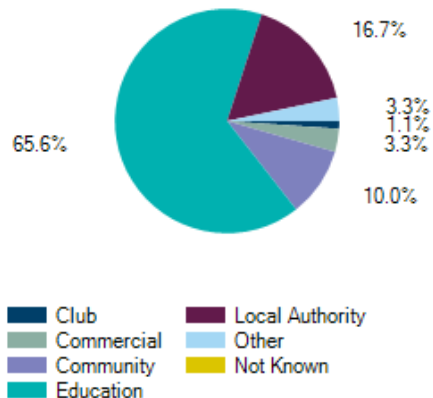

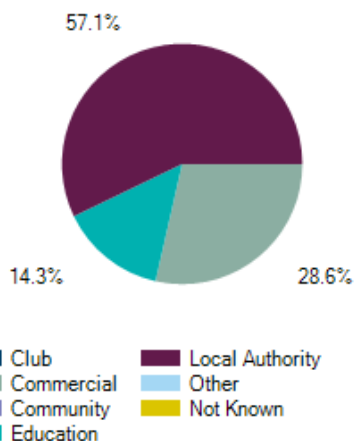

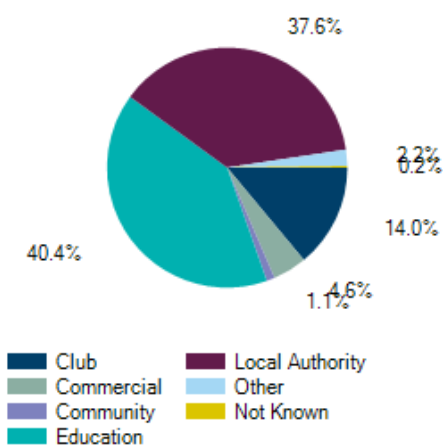

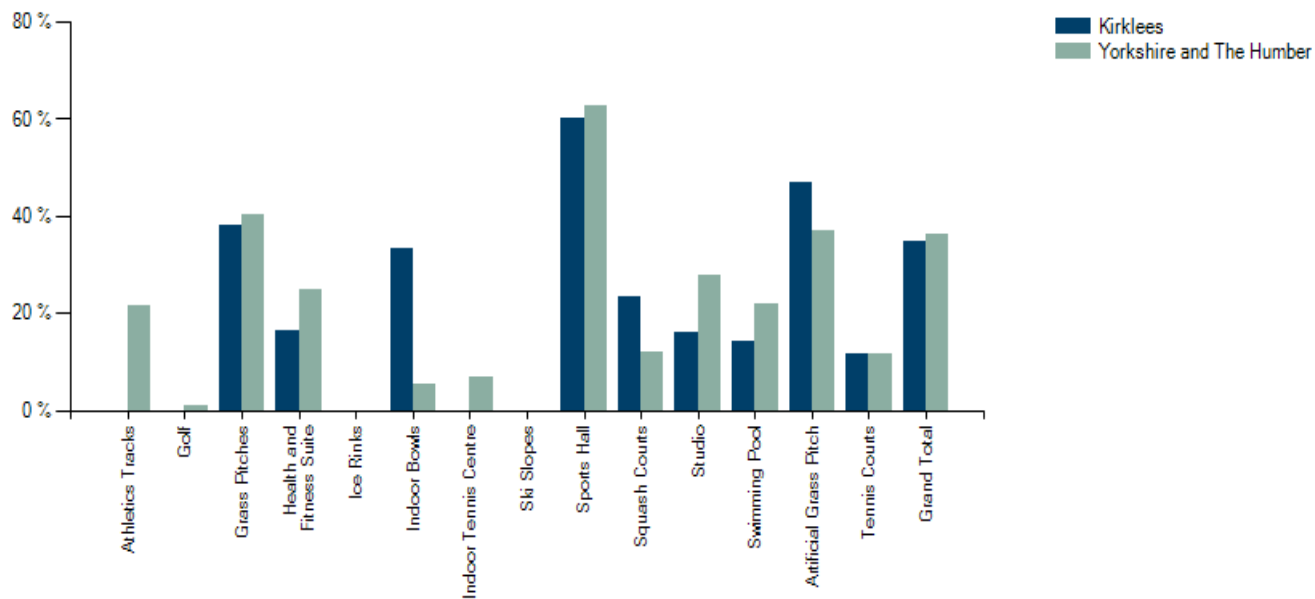

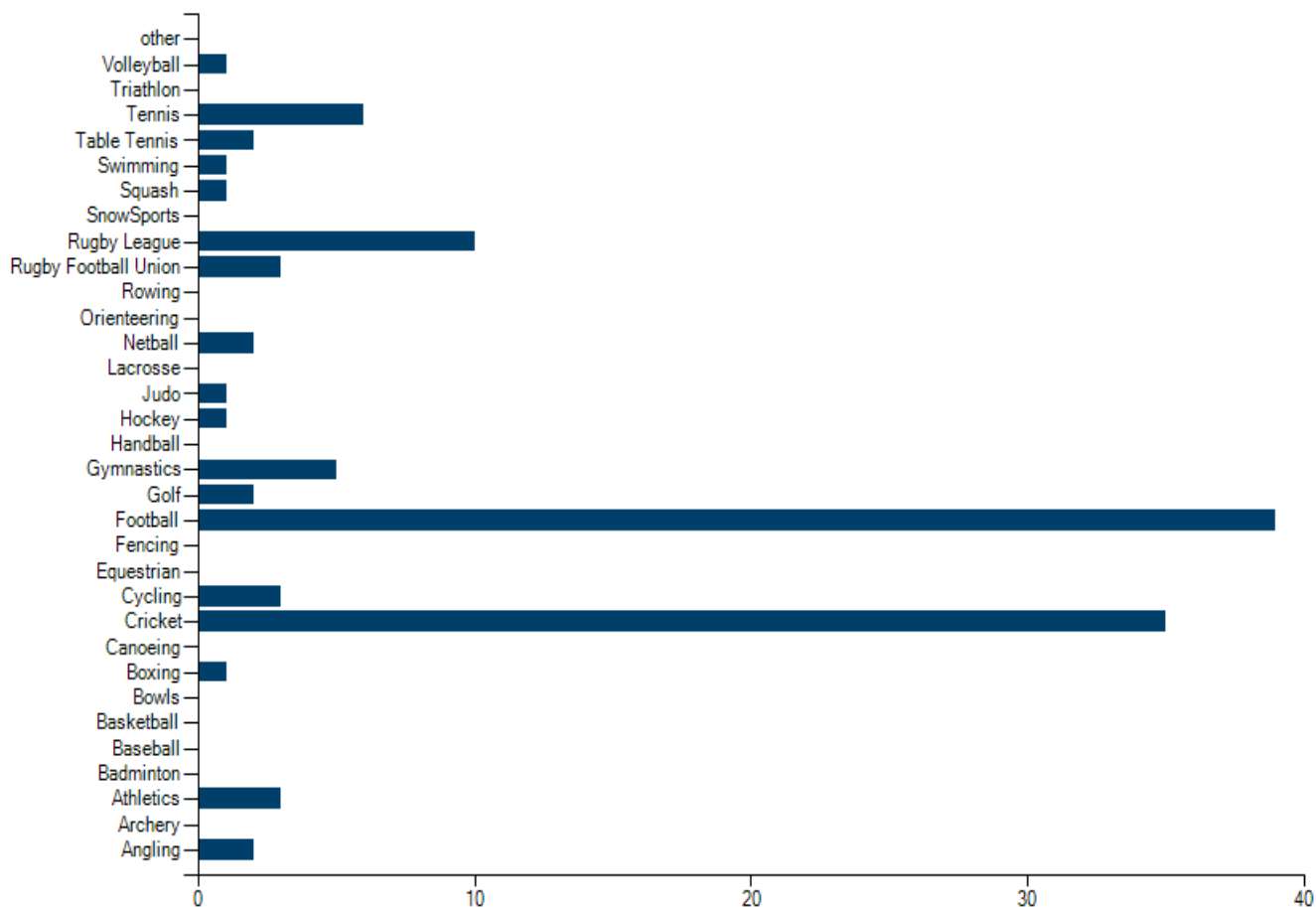

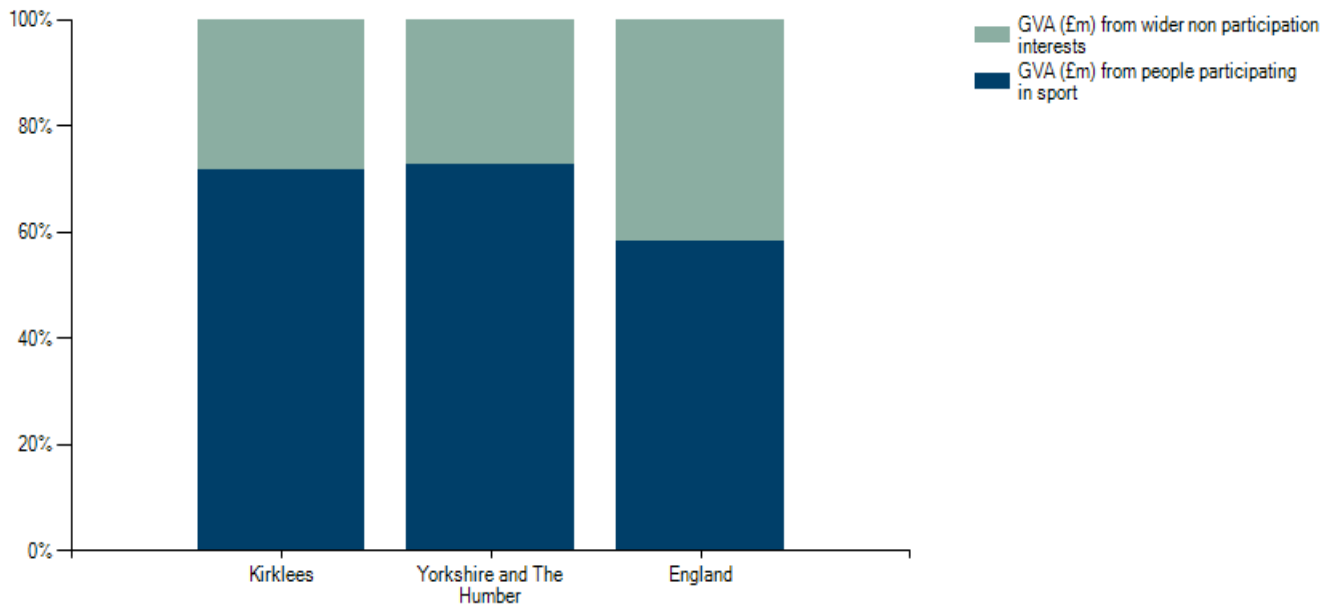

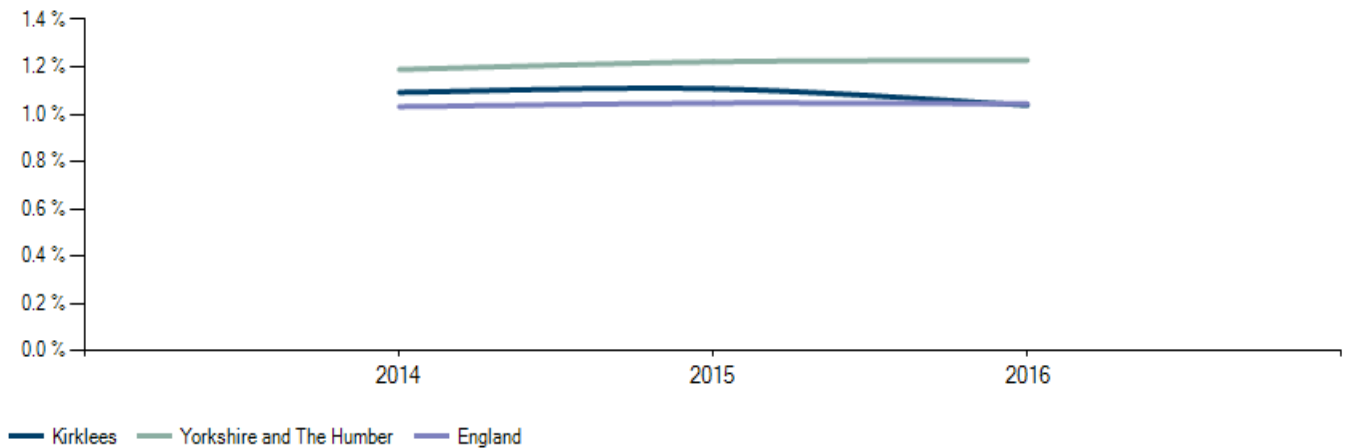

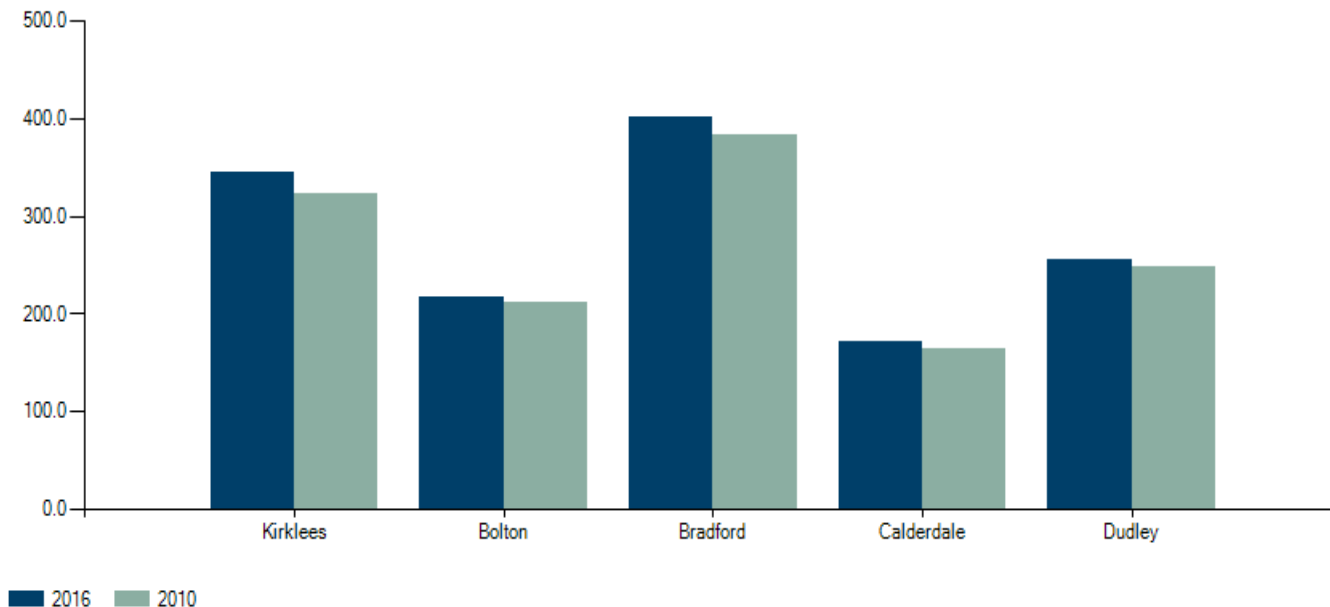

## Nearest neighbour population comparison (000s)



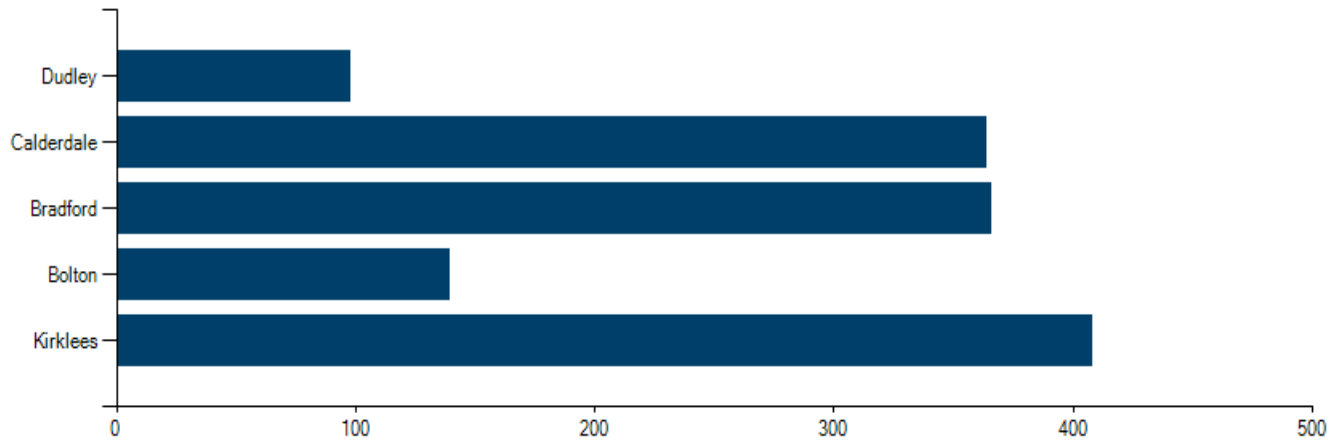

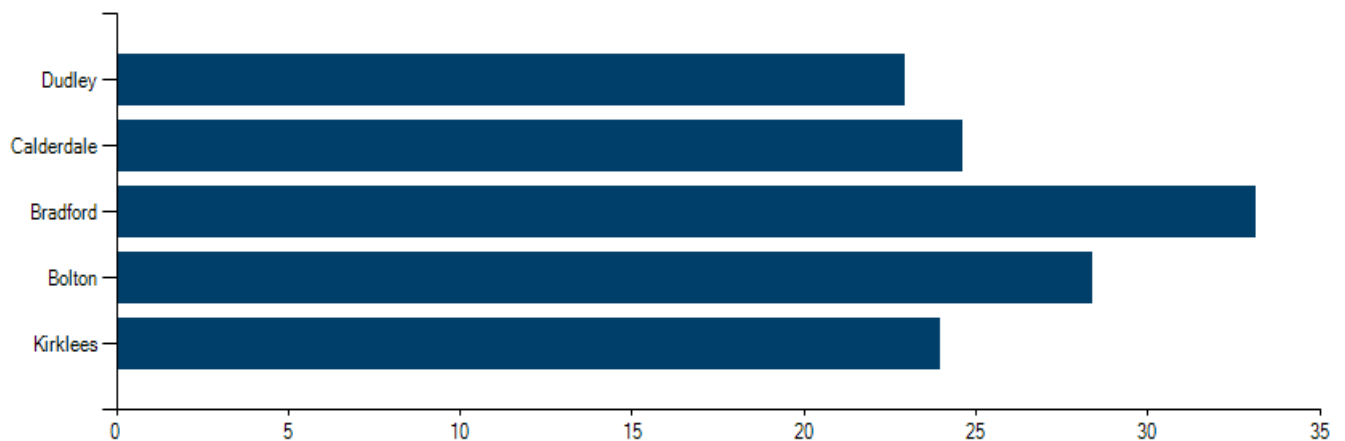

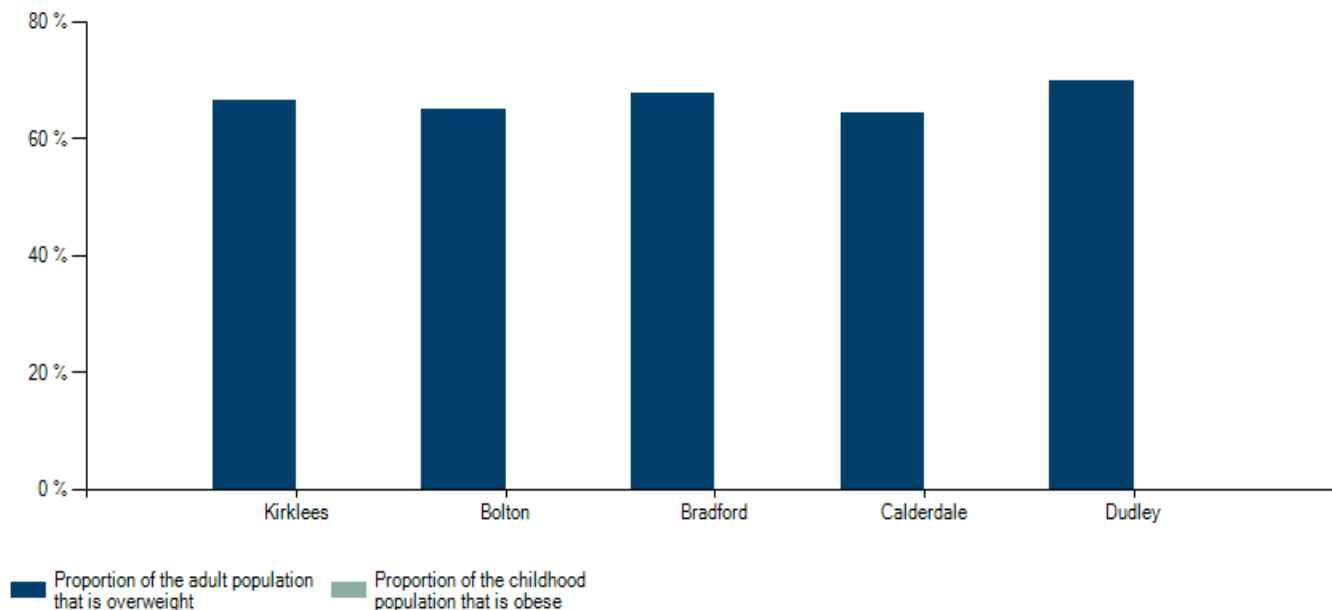

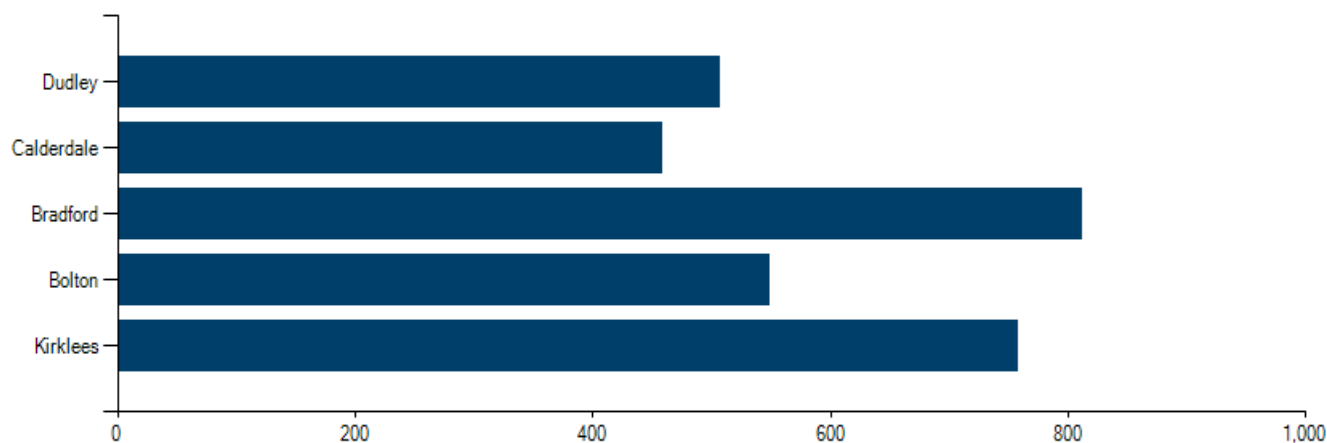
