

Summary of differences: Batley & Birstall PCN

CLiK summary

Across 52 indicators, Batley and Birstall PCN was one of the best three PCNs for 16 indicators and one of the worst three PCNs for 12 indicators. A higher proportion of residents in Batley and Birstall had intentions to quit smoking compared to Kirklees overall. Residents were also more likely to agree that the things they do in life are worthwhile, and were more likely to be happy.

Residents within the Batley and Birstall PCN area were more likely on average to have 3 or more prescription medicines. They were also less likely to eat five portions of fruit and vegetables per day compared to the Kirklees average. Residents in the Batley West ward were the most likely to say their overall physical health was bad or very bad compared to wards across Kirklees.

CLiK: Long-term health conditions

Anxiety and depression were the most reported LTC for Batley and Birstall PCN, with rates slightly lower for both compared to the Kirklees average. There are higher rates of high blood pressure and musculoskeletal/rheumatological conditions compared to Kirklees overall in Batley and Birstall PCN.




